



BISHOP INDIAN TRIBAL COUNCIL JOB DESCRIPTION



POSITION: Biological Technician
SUPERVISOR: Environmental Specialist
STATUS: Temporary
PAY RATE: \$10.00/Hr.
HOURS PER WEEK: 10 hours/week after school through the end of school year (schedule to be arranged) or when all samples have been processed which ever comes first.
SCHOOL CREDIT (optional): To be arranged by student with appropriate science instructor.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Biological Technician will be responsible for the processing and identification of samples of benthic macroinvertebrates (aquatic insects) in the Bishop Paiute Tribe Environmental Laboratory.

GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Pick and subsample aquatic insects	Enter field data into computer database
Identify aquatic insects with microscope	Perform other technical tasks as assigned
Keep accurate and legible field and lab notes	Maintain the laboratory and laboratory equipment

QUALIFICATIONS:

- must be Sophomore or above at Bishop Union High School, Jill Kinmont Boothe School or Palisades High School
- must have successfully passed one course of high school level Biology with a grade C or above
- must have a grade point average of a minimum of 2.50 as evidenced by quarterly grade submittals
- must demonstrate initiative, commitment, dedicated work ethic, and positive attitude to job duties and tribal environmental goals and objectives
- must demonstrate basic knowledge of the unique sovereign status of Indian Tribes and respect for Paiute/Shoshone cultures
- must be able to pass a drug test
