2021 WILDFIRES SUMMARY

This is a list of the primary fires affecting the northern Owens Valley in terms of smoke. All fires were caused by lightning except for The Pine Fire, Caldor Fire, French, and Dixie Fires, causes officially under investigation or unknown.

Pine Fire: Inyo National Forest (near Round Valley), 7/7 – 7/8, 25 acres

Glacier Fire: Inyo National Forest (near Big Pine), 7/14 – 7/23, 41 acres

Inyo Creek Fire: Inyo National Forest (near Lone Pine), 6/19 – 7/2, 592 acres

Dexter Fire: Inyo National Forest (near June Lakes), 7/12 – 7/28, 2,965 acres

Walkers Fire: Sequoia National Forest, 8/? - 9/17, 8,777 acres

French Fire: BLM/Sequoia National Forest, 8/18 – 10/1, 26,535 acres

Tamarack Fire: Humboldt-Toiyabe Forest Topaz, 7/4 – 8/25, 68,637 acres

KNP Complex Fire: Sequoia Kings National Park, 9/9 – now, 87,786 acres

Windy Fire: Sequoia National Forest, 6/21 – estimated 11/1, 97,554 acres

Beckwourth Complex Fire: Plumas National Forest, 7/3 – 8/30, 105,670 acres

Caldor Fire: Eldorado National Forest, 8/14 – 10/21, 221,798 acres

Dixie Fire: Lassen National Forest, 7/13 – estimated 10/30, 963,309 acres
